	<b>ESCE will accommodate as much as possible to register the students in the courses they have selected however, in order to avoid any time table clashes, we highly advise students to select courses in the same specializations.</b>
<b>LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS</b>	French and/or English Language requirements: no official test required but level B2 expected to study business courses in French or in English
<b>LANGUAGE COURSE</b>	French Language course optional for all international students (free of charge): beginner, intermediate, or advanced level. No beginner language course offered in other languages.
<b>WINTER/SUMMER SHORT-TERM PROGRAMS</b>	<b>Summer program (July):</b> Contact: <a href="mailto:summer@campuseiffel.fr">summer@campuseiffel.fr</a> (fee-paying) 3 weeks, Business courses taught in English and in Spanish, French Language and Culture program
<b>WORK PLACEMENT</b>	Work placement/Internship possible after a minimum of one semester of study at ESCE only if placement/internship is part of the study at the home institution and mandatory in the curriculum.
<b>HOUSING</b>	Off-campus student residences: We offer single-inhabitant studios, single bedrooms in shared flats, double bedrooms in shared flats. Rent €650 – €950 per month. Rent, deposit, and reservation fee should be paid by bank transfer to reserve the room. Some residences require advance payment of the rent.
<b>HEALTH INSURANCE</b>	<b>EU Students:</b> E111 European Health card, to present upon arrival at ESCE <b>NON EU Students:</b> French Health insurance <b>mandatory for 2019/2020</b> . Information about the health insurance will be sent before the start of the semester/year.
<b>VISA</b>	An invitation letter will be sent to Non EU students to start their Visa application via Campus France or the French consulate. <b>NON EU students coming from a European university: Visa is mandatory because European residence card ONLY allows students to visit France for 90 days but not to study in France.</b>
